- 1. **Paul Iossa, discussion of building on Main Street**: Paul Iossa described the Main Street building, explaining the septic tank is outdated and definitely needs replacing. The purchase price is \$89,900 but no reasonable offer will be refused. Jonesport will have the first refusal. Selectperson Fish made a motion to approve a house inspection, along with a septic inspection. Selectperson Alley seconded the motion.
- 2. **New bids for sand:** There were no bids for providing the sand for 2024-25 winter. Selectperson Fish made the motion to put the sand out for bid once again. Selectperson Cilley seconded the motion.
