- The East lot boundary info apparently can be obtained from Lennie Durkee's deed per communication with Diane Smith. (A copy will need to be procured to assist in establishing that line.)
- Lot maintenance: Sandra Watson has volunteered to maintain the memorial grounds once established. Suggested that VFW and American Legion be asked to participate in upkeep also. Suggested that annual town funds be allocated for memorial maintenance. (Amount to be determined.)
- Budget: shorefront fencing (for safety) has been added as a line item. A quote for the stones is to be sent to town office. Al will confirm same with the monument company.
- Etchings/Sayings: members were asked to submit their suggestions so the committee can choose what will be engraved.
- Signage: a temporary 3ft x 3ft. "future home of JVM" was approved to be made by JTPC to be placed on the High Street lot. Cynthia will inform Brett to proceed with making the sign. The stand will be a separate item/fee.

Questions:

- JBGC asked questions (thru Diane) about plot plan, parking, start date.
- Has the abutter Marjorie been contacted about future lot plans?
- What about memorial security (e.g., video cameras)?
- Have liability issues been addressed?
- Who will ensure proper flag protocol is followed?
